- Since 2000, Academic Decathlon teams from LAUSD have won twelve National Championships. In 2016, thirteen LAUSD teams competed in the California Academic Decathlon Finals. Granada Hills HS won the State and National titles, Marshall HS won the National Online title for large schools, seven students from Franklin HS and one from Garfield HS competed at Nationals and collectively won 65 medals.
- BTB/Harmony Project Youth Orchestras teach students to master a musical instrument at seven schools with over 500 student participants.
