Priority 1 - Findings

Basics (Teachers, Instructional Materials, Facilities)

- Percentage of mis-assignments of teachers of English Learners: 1%
- Percentage of total teacher mis-assignments: 11%
- ✓ Number of vacant teacher positions: 388
- Percentage of students without access to their own copies of standards-aligned instructional materials for use at school and at home: 0%
- ✓ Number of identified instances where facilities do not meet the "good repair" standard: o





Priority 2 - Findings

Implementation of Academic Standards

The District findings in this area indicate:

- LAUSD uses standards-aligned curricula within a multi-tiered system of support framework to deliver instruction that prepares students for a successful transition to college, career and life.
- LAUSD is at full implementation of core academic standards





Priority 3 - Findings

Parent and Family Engagement

- √ 90% of schools hosted at least four academic workshops
- ✓ 100% of schools established a School Site Council at the start of the new school year.
- ✓ School Experience Survey (SES) results indicate families feel welcomed to participate at school (89% for ES, 82% MS, 82% HS)
- ✓ SES results indicated that families received school information they can understand (94% for ES, 89% for MS, and 87% for HS).
- ✓ SES results show that families participate in teacher events, like parent teacher conferences (90% for ES, 78% for MS, 73% for HS)





Priority 6 - Findings

Local Climate Survey

78% student survey participation

- ✓ Schools were perceived to be safe places by at least 73% of students.
- ▼ The percentage rates of middle and high school students reporting being happy at school were 74% and 67% respectively.
- √ 62% of middle school students reported feeling like they are part of their school and 59% for high school students.
- ▼ 81% of elementary students, 65% of middle school students and 62% of high school students indicated that adults treated them with respect.



Priority 7 - Findings

Access to a Broad Course of Study


- ✓ Measures or tools used to track students' access to a broad course of study:
