

COVID-19 HAS IMPACTED MY CHILD'S CLASSROOM. WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW?

What learning will look like for your child and their class during a COVID-related quarantine.

<p>My child has to quarantine (but the whole class is not in quarantine):</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Students who are quarantined have the option to access their class and all class periods for live instruction.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Teachers will provide in-person instruction in their classroom with non-quarantined students.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Assignments will be completed using the class's digital platform.
<p>My child's entire class (or period in middle school or high school) has to quarantine:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Pre-K and elementary students will have the option to access online instruction with their teacher for a minimum of 3 hours each day.Middle and high school students will have the option to access online instruction with their teachers for a minimum of 30 minutes per class.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Students will complete independent work and may access office hours when not attending in person instruction.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Assignments will be completed using the class's digital platform.
<p>Quarantined teachers (exposed or asymptomatic) would be providing services. Those in isolation (ill) would be out on illness.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Students who do not need to quarantine will attend class in-person with a substitute teacher, so both the quarantined teacher and substitute teacher will be available to support learning.Quarantined teachers will provide virtual instruction for in-person and quarantined students.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">During class time, teachers will use breakout rooms to support small-group instruction for quarantined students.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Assignments will be completed using the class's digital platform.
<p>Absences What you need to know:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Students with excused absences will be given full credit for any make up work, just as with any excused absence.	<p>For more information on checking out hotspots or devices for your child, call your school or visit: device.lausd.net.</p>	

If your child is required to quarantine or isolate, please let your principal or school site team know if your child still wants access to daily meals. The school will make arrangements for you to pick up meals for the duration of your student's quarantine period.
