**SUBJECT: NOTICE OF EXEMPTION FROM DAILY DRINKING WATER
FLUSHING REQUIREMENTS**

The Office of Environmental Health and Safety (OEHS) has conducted an evaluation of sampling data at Dr. Julian Nava Learning Academy School of Arts and Culture (0001807001) and Dr. Julian Nava Learning Academy School of Business and Technology (0001517301) as requested by the Facilities Services Division (FSD). OEHS has determined that lead levels are below the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's and the District's thresholds for lead in drinking water. As such, daily flushing activities at Dr. Julian Nava Learning Academy School of Arts and Culture and Dr. Julian Nava Learning Academy School of Business and Technology may cease.

Quality assurance/control sampling will be randomly conducted at school sites and if necessary, corrective measures will be implemented. If it is determined that daily flushing is then required, you will be notified in writing.
