AMENDMENT TO THE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY DIVISION STRATEGIC
EXECUTION PLAN TO PURCHASE DEVICES AND CARTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF
EQUIPPING SCHOOLS TO COMPLETE THE SBAC TESTING

WHEREAS, District Staff proposes that the Board of Education amend the Information Technology Division (ITD) Strategic Execution Plan (SEP) to update the Common Core Technology Project (CCTP) as provided in Board Report No. 128-14/15 attached hereto in the form in which it was presented to the Bond Oversight Committee (BOC) and incorporated herein by this reference, to take the following actions (the "Project"):

1. Purchase for and equip Non-Phase 1, 1L and 2a schools with storage/charging carts stocked with tablet devices and physical keyboards or Chromebooks necessary to successfully conduct the 2015 Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium testing next Spring and K-5 DIBELS assessment.

Based on the number of students required to take the four separate assessments, the amount of time given to complete the assessments, and feedback given during the Spring 2014 SBAC Field Test, District Staff estimates the total not-to-exceed number of storage/charging carts to be purchased to be approximately 624 charging carts, consisting of 21,840 iPads and physical keyboards or Chromebooks (35 of each per cart).

2. Authorize District Staff to execute all instruments necessary to implement approved Phases and project scopes for the CCTP, including procurement actions (under Public Contract Code sections 20118.1 and/or 20111, where appropriate) for the purchase of Chromebooks or tablet and keyboards, and accessories.

WHEREAS, District Staff states in the accompanying Board Report that the cost of purchasing these devices, peripherals, and carts, as well as the cost to provision and manage them, is \$25,989,038; and

WHEREAS, District Staff states that the total budget for the Project is \$25,989,038, and that there are remaining funds from the District's purchase for the Spring 2014 Field Test in the amount of \$9,216,491 that would be applied to this purchase, resulting in a request for an allocation of additional bond funds in the amount of \$16,772,547;

WHEREAS, District Staff confirms that number of devices stated as being needed in the accompanying Board Report is based on the number District Staff estimates would be needed to permit all students to take the Spring 2014 Field Test during the same two-hour period in the morning, and that if instead one-half of the students took the test during a two-hour period in the morning and the other one-half of the students took the test during a two-hour period in the afternoon, then the number of new devices needed would be many less than stated in the Board Report, if any;

WHEREAS, District Staff confirms that the District does not have an accurate inventory of the number of devices already at the schools that could be used by students to take the Spring 2014 Field Test; and

WHEREAS, District Staff has concluded that the proposed SEP amendment will facilitate implementation of the ITD SEP, and therefore, it will not adversely affect the District's ability to successfully complete the ITD SEP.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The School Construction Bond Citizens' Oversight Committee (BOC) does not recommend the purchase of any additional devices at this time, but the BOC would be inclined to consider and recommend a proposal to purchase additional devices for testing if presented with a calculation as to the number of devices needed for purchase or rent that was based on an assumption that the devices would be used for four (4) hours per day when possible. Further, the BOC would urge that the District, in determining the number and type of devices to be acquired, consider the long range use of those devices and that the District provide assurances that sufficient support staff would be provided in connection with the testing.
2. This resolution shall be transmitted to the Los Angeles Unified School District Board of Education and posted on the Bond Oversight Committee's website.
3. That a written response as required by the Charter and Memorandum of Understanding between the Oversight Committee and the Board be provided to the Oversight

BOARD REPORT

Action Proposed: Staff proposes that the Board of Education amend the Information Technology Division (ITD) Strategic Execution Plan (SEP) to update the Common Core Technology Project (CCTP, also known as "Project") and take the following actions:

- Purchase and equip Project schools as follows:
 - Non-Phase 1, 1L and 2a schools with storage/charging carts stocked with tablet devices and physical keyboards or Chromebooks necessary to successfully conduct the 2015 Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium testing next Spring and K-5 DIBELS assessment.

Based on the number of students required to take the four separate assessments, the amount of time given to complete the assessments, and feedback given during the Spring 2014 SBAC Field Test, staff estimates the total not-to-exceed number of storage/charging carts to be purchased to be approximately 624 charging carts, consisting of 21,840 iPads and physical keyboards or Chromebooks (35 of each per cart).

- Authorize staff to execute all instruments necessary to implement approved Phases and project scopes for the CCTP, including procurement actions (under Public Contract Code sections 20118.1

and/or 20111, where appropriate) for the purchase of Chromebooks or tablet and keyboards, and accessories.

Background:

The proposed actions will enable the District to comply with the Board of Education's directive to implement a second phase of the testing device purchase and distribution, advancing efforts to modernize classrooms, prepare students to master Common Core State Standards, facilitate students' proficient use of digital learning technology, equip educators with tools to advance student learning in the classroom, and further close the digital divide between those students who have and do not have access to the most advanced learning tools available.

The District collected a variety of data and feedback during the Spring 2014 SBAC field testing. Several factors drove the need for the purchase of additional testing devices.

Schools were allocated the minimum amount devices to complete the 2013-14 Smarter Balanced Field Test based on an estimate of four hours of testing per student. The Field Test did not include the full portions of ELA and math. For the 2014-15 Smarter Balanced Test (operational test), students in grades 3-8 and 11 will take the operational test with an average testing time of 8-9 hours per student to complete the full ELA and math portions.

Additional testing devices are needed based the increased testing time per student and on feedback from schools via survey and focus groups.

Principals and testing coordinators indicated that the state allotted testing window of six weeks was too long and disruptive to instruction and suggested a shorter testing window. Additionally, this year's test will produce student level results for accountability purposes. It is extremely important for students to have sufficient time to become familiar with the testing device and its' features before the test.

Additionally, district staff recommends purchasing tablets for administering the K-5 DIBELS assessment which requires a touch screen.

Expected Outcomes:

Approval of the proposed actions and the subsequent investment in testing devices will begin immediately upon approval.

Board Options and Consequences:

Approval of this action will enable full implementation of Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium and DIBELS testing. Failure to approve the proposed actions will limit the ability of all schools to participate effectively in the Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium and DIBELS testing.

**Policy
Implications:**

This action is consistent with the District's long-term goal to address unmet school facilities needs as described in Measures R, Y and Q.

Budget Impact:
