# AMENDMENT TO THE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY DIVISION STRATEGIC EXECUTION PLAN TO REVISE AND APPROVE THE BUDGET AND SCHEDULE FOR THE MARLTON SCHOOL INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY NETWORK MODERNIZATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, District Staff proposes that the Board of Education approve an amendment to the Information Technology Division (ITD) 2014 Strategic Execution Plan (SEP) to revise the Marlton School Project with an updated budget of \$4,394,163 and extend the completion date to the first quarter of 2016; and

WHEREAS, this action will update the project budget and schedule of the Marlton School Project (the "Project") previously approved by the Board of Education on December 12, 2014 (Board of Education Report Number 255 – 14/15) with a budget of \$2,981,055 to replace obsolete and failing public address and intercommunications systems by converging and enabling new equipment, features, and services on the upgraded network; and

WHEREAS, the previous budget was based on construction estimates prior to the release of a bid; the actual proposal award, after a Best and Final Offer (BAFO), was \$3,044,328.64 or approximately forty-two percent greater than original estimates; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to increase the project budget by \$1,413,108 due to the changing market conditions; and

WHEREAS, this proposed action reallocates a total of \$1,413,108 in project network equipment savings from fifty-one LAN Modernization projects (see attachment A) to the Marlton Network Project. There is no general fund impact; and

## BOARD REPORT

**Action Proposed:** 

Staff proposes that the Board of Education amend the Information Technology Division 2014 Strategic Execution Plan (SEP) to revise and approve the budget and schedule for the Marlton School Information Technology Network Modernization Project. The project budget is currently defined with a \$2,981,055 funding allocation as listed in the 2014 Information Technology (IT) Strategic Execution Plan approved by the Board on December 9, 2014 (Board of Education Report Number 255 – 14/15). This proposed action allocates \$1,413,108 of savings from fifty-one LAN Modernization projects (see attachment) where reduction in network equipment costs contributed to project savings, allowing reallocation of bond funds to meet the unique daily communication needs of Marlton's hearing impaired students and school staff. If approved, the new budget will be \$4,394,163 and the projected completion date will be the first quarter of 2016.

**Background:** 

Marlton School has approximately 300 students and 35 teachers; approximately 60% of the students and school staff are hard-ofhearing. Marlton consists of about 40 classrooms, a multi-purpose room, a gymnasium, a library, and a cafeteria. The school has an immediate need for converged audio/visual address/intercommunication services ("A/V PA-Intercom system") that allow announcements and daily communication to be displayed on classroom monitors for those who read lips or understand sign language. Visual communication is an important part of daily communications, safety requirements and teaching for the hearing impaired. This system will operate on the recently upgraded data network, allowing replacement of the existing public address and

intercommunication equipment and cabling that is obsolete and unreliable. This critical upgrade will enable daily communications as well as notifications during times of emergencies.

The previous budget was based on construction estimates prior to the release of a bid. The actual proposal award, after a Best and Final Offer (BAFO), was \$3,044,328.64 or approximately forty-two percent greater than original estimates.

The proposed action will provide the District with additional budget and time to implement a converged A/V PA-Intercom that is part of the Marlton School IT Network Modernization Project.

The school is located in Board District 1.

**Expected Outcomes:** Approval of the proposed action and the subsequent investments in

upgrades and replacement of obsolete and failing aging telephone, public

address, intercommunication, and network infrastructure at Marlton.

**Board Options and Consequences:** 

Approval of the proposed action will provide additional funding needed to implement the converged A/V PA-Intercom system that is part of the Marlton School IT Network Modernization Project. If the proposed action is not approved, Marlton's telecommunications systems will continue aging and failing. Students and staff will not have reliable and working systems for daily and emergency communication.

Policy Implications: This action is consistent with the District's long-term goal to modernize

technological infrastructure to support the needs of our students and staff.


**Budget Impact:** This proposed action impacts Bond Project funds only. Funding will be

reallocated between approved network projects and will not impact overall Bond Program Funds allocated to IT Network Modernization Projects within ITD's Strategic Execution Plan. There is no anticipated

impact to General Fund.

Bond Oversight Committee Recommendations: This item was considered by the School Construction Bond Citizens' Oversight Committee (BOC) at its February 26, 2015 meeting. Staff has concluded that this proposed SEP Amendment will facilitate the implementation of the ITD-SEP, and therefore it will not adversely affect

the District's ability to successfully complete the ITD-SEP.
