AMENDMENT TO THE FACILITIES SERVICES DIVISION STRATEGIC EXECUTION PLAN TO DEFINE AND APPROVE THREE PROJECTS THAT ADDRESS SCHOOL NEEDS IDENTIFIED BY BOARD DISTRICT THREE

WHEREAS, District staff proposes that the Board of Education approve an amendment to the Facilities Services Division (FSD) Strategic Execution Plan (SEP) to define and approve three projects to address needs identified by Board District Three with a combined budget of \$526,186 as described in Board Report 072-15/16 attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2010, the Board of Education approved the establishment of the Capital Improvement Program (CIPR), and allocated funds to priority projects and a capital needs assessment/planning effort (BOE#30-09/10); and

WHEREAS, the establishment of CIPR included the allocation of \$25,000,000 for one or more capital improvement priority projects in Board District Three; and

WHEREAS, since 2010, the Board of Education has approved one hundred and one (101) Board District Three CIPR priority projects; and

WHEREAS, the projects described in Board Report 072-15/16 will upgrade, modernize and/or enhance the learning environment for students; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education's approval of the projects described in Board Report 072-15/16 will authorize District Staff to proceed with the expenditure of bond funds to undertake the Project in accordance with the provisions set forth in Measures K, R, Y and Q; and

BOARD REPORT

Action Proposed:	Staff proposes that the Board of Education approve an amendment to the Facilities Services Division (FSD) Strategic Execution Plan (SEP) to define and approve three projects that meet priority needs in Board District 3. The scope, schedule and budget for the three proposed projects are described in Attachment A. The total combined budget for the three projects is \$526,186.
Background:	On April 13, 2010, the Board of Education approved the establishment of the Capital Improvement Program (CIPR), and allocated funds to priority projects and a capital needs assessment/planning effort (BOE#30-09/10). This action included the allocation of \$25,000,000 for one or more capital improvement priority projects in Board District 3. Since 2010, the Board of Education has approved one hundred and one (101) Board District 3 CIPR priority projects.
Expected Outcomes:	Execution of these projects will improve the learning environment for students, teachers, and staff and support safety and accessibility at the three campuses.
Board Options and Consequences:	A "yes" vote will authorize staff to proceed with the expenditure of bond funds to undertake the three proposed projects. If the proposed action is not approved, bond funds will not be expended and the priority needs identified by Board Member Schmerelson will remain unaddressed.
Policy Implications:	These actions are consistent with the District's commitment to address unmet school facilities needs and provide students with a safe and healthy learning environment.

Budget Impact:	The total combined budget for the three projects is \$526,186. The projects will be funded with Bond Program funds earmarked specifically for priority improvements at schools in Board District 3.

Bond Oversight Committee Recommendations:	This item was considered by the School Construction Bond Citizens' Oversight Committee (BOC) at its meeting of September 24, 2015. 1. Andasol Elementary School – New Kindergarten Play Equipment and Shade Structure Local District Northwest, Board District 3 - Schmerelson

- Project Background and Scope This project is to remove the deteriorated and obsolete play
 equipment in the kindergarten yard and to install a new shade structure over new play equipment
 to protect the children while at play.
- Project Budget -- \$220,000
- *Project Schedule* Construction is anticipated to begin in Q4 2016, and conclude in Q2 2017.

2. Chatsworth Park Elementary School – Lunch Area Improvement Project

Local District Northwest, Board District 3 - Schmerelson

- Project Background and Scope This project is to install new wind-barrier fencing around the two existing lunch shelters, provide new lunch tables and new playground benches in the lunch shelter area, and to install additional wall-mounted folding tables in the adjacent auditorium.
- Project Budget -- \$99,600
- *Project Schedule* Construction is anticipated to begin in Q1 2016, and conclude in Q2 2016.

3. Topeka Drive Elementary School – Shade Structures (2) in Kindergarten Playground Local District Northwest, Board District 3 - Schmerelson

- Project Background and Scope This project is to install a new shade structure over the existing
 play equipment in the Kindergarten yard and to install a new shade structure over the lunch
 tables used by the children for outdoor meals and play.
- *Project Budget* -- \$206,586
- *Project Schedule* Construction is anticipated to begin in Q4 2016, and conclude in Q2 2017.
