Action Proposed:

Staff proposes that the Board of Education approve the Fiscal Year 2021 Office of the Inspector General (OIG) Work Plan.

Background:

The Office of the Inspector General (OIG) conducts its auditing functions pursuant to Government Auditing Standards and to auditing standards included in the International Professional Practices framework.
