Recommendations for 2014/15 Human Relations Awards

- Open applications in November; give awards in May
- Encourage board members, commissioners and operations coordinators to nominate schools in their region.
- Include affiliated charters in this year's pool.
- Present at principals' meeting

Commissioners will follow up with their board members regarding donations for the Human Relations awards.

Discussed starting a website for Human Relations Commission with spotlights, a newsletter, calendar, and a subscription list and securing stationery and business cards. Bud Jacobs/Hop Tarrant will draft.

Discussed the need for internal champions

Robin Toma, LA County HR, is reaching out to schools with outstanding Human Relations efforts. The commission will endorse his efforts.

Next meeting is December 11, already sent via Meeting Wizard.

Staff report on current campaigns and efforts of HRDE and School Operations:

- Bullying training of trainers cancelled
- Commercial exploitation of children going forward
- LGBTQ out reach, National Coming Out Day, OUT for Safe Schools: Blow the Whistle on Hate
- Audit completed
- Sexual Harassment among Adolescents

The County is continuing to work with the District on Sexual Exploitation of Children. The Commission will write a board informative or endorse one that may be under consideration by an existing board member. A Board resolution remains pending

Commission is interested in supporting the expansion of Human Relations, Diversity & Equity and would like to resume the monthly reports of HRDE's work to be submitted in advance.

Move: recommend adoption of a required ethnic studies course for high school. Find out who in the District would be leading this and their perspective. Reportedly, 4 board members are supporting it.

Hate crimes dropped for anti-gay male and anti-Jewish. The number of minors who perpetrated hate crimes dropped also.

Gangs and hate crimes in communities of color have not changed significantly.

Commission wondered who is doing gang intervention work in the District.
