SB 1165-Sexual Abuse and Trafficking Prevention Education Board Resolution draft (Mark Abelsson)

Discussion – Robin will run past the LAUSD Taskforce on Commercial Sex Trafficking of Children.

Train - Relies on sexual health education curriculum. Are there other areas of the comprehensive sexual health education law where this should be integrated?

Watts – if the average age of entry is 12, then a high school curriculum is too late. Need a parent component. Instruction needs to be age-appropriate.

Jacobs - clarify the reporting process and incorporate into child abuse training.

Website (Sara Train)

Presented a draft of the intro page to the Commission's tab on the Human Relations website.

Wittig – list areas where the commission has expertise Include activities & events

Include links for bullying, etc., and resources

Tarrant - "profiles to encourage" to showcase schools, staff, students. "Chain of events," "awards" with descriptions, application for awards; press release; how to donate/sponsor Watts – include data that speaks to the challenges the commission is trying to address De la Rosa – include an email address to write to the commission. Emails would bounce to Judy Chiasson

Train – all should submit personal bios

Restorative Justice – Watts would like a presentation by Restorative Justice by someone who is in the field. Believes that RJ does not discuss race.

Ethnic Studies – Watts is concerned who is teaching Ethnic Studies. Concerned about the skills of teachers managing the volatility of managing dynamics around race Rosa – request to have a commissioner on the taskforce to bring ethnic studies Wittig – request to have a representative from the task force on ethnic studies Abelsson – will this be about ethnicity only? What about other variables, such as sexual orientation, gender identity, religion, etc. Should be a diversity studies. Proposed that the board be advised that "ethnic studies" is too narrow.

Tarrant - is the intent to learn about oneself or to learn about the "other"
