#### Resolution on religious intolerance and extremism.

Review OGC's analysis of the resolution on religious intolerance and violent extremism. Gary de la Rosa will take the lead on revising the resolution. The new direction will have a human relations lens and focus on violence motivated by religious intolerance and by religious extremism. Chiasson sent a revision to OGC for approval, but has not heard back. Will follow up again.

Kakassy is interested in a stand-alone student handbook or an app. He has an appointment with Earl Perkins next week.

Kakassy discussed concerns on qualifications of teachers and their skills to address sensitive topics. Chiasson & Kakassy will discuss on Monday at 1 pm
