Commissioner Watts lead discussion on overview of Educational Equity's Ad Hoc's actions.

"Equity" is used by Funding, Discipline & Safety, Academic proficiency, Staffing, et al. Settle on improving promising practices to systemically increase academic proficiency and opportunity gaps.

Group agrees that there should be an equity 'czar' to ensure coherence, integration and synergy among the silos.

Commissioners discussed the Guiding Strategies. Proposed for acceptance with correction of non-material typographical errors. Approved unanimously.

Commission discussed the proposed resolution for additional human relations specialists and the extent to which the job duties represent the diversity and equity (in addition to human relations) duties.

Commissioners inquired as to data regarding incidents that are recorded by the District.

Watts posed discussion as to the extent that a more harmonious campus results in increased academic achievement, such as identity safety.

Recommend streamline the proposal. Commissioner Kakassy will make the edits and resubmit the commission for approval.

Bud Jacobs will be presenting at an RJ meeting tomorrow regarding the Human Relations Commission Award. Commissions recommended adding immigration as an issue to be addressed.

Proposal on Social Emotional Learning. Commission discussed to what extent the Commission should focus its efforts and refining the language in the resolution to "support SEL program in Health Education Programs" and remove language that calls for allocation of resources to maintain or expand. Abelsson also wants the opportunity to review the resources.

All commissioners who knew Obie Slamon and Charles Narcho will each write two statements regarding them for inclusion in board proclamations. Chiasson will compile the contributions.
