Lina Kholak shared incidents of bias at schools, specifically misconceptions about Muslims. Requested the commission to offer workshops about Islam.

Hadir Elsayad, MPAC, shared the importance of meaningful opportunities to learn about Muslim and counter misconceptions. MPAC is participating on the Ethnic studies commission.

Gary De La Rosa requested the opportunity to view a training.

District passed a resolution on Islamophobia this academic year. The Commission had made a statement on Islamophobia in 2015.

Commissioners brainstormed on increasing awareness at schools, including classes through Museum of Tolerance, student speaker at a board meeting, inclusion in newsletters.

Lina and Hadir will send guidelines for Ramadan to Judy for distribution to principals and materials for consideration for posting on the HRDE website.

Tanya presented on LACP, explained the calculation of and distribution of resources based on the three high needs populations – foster, English Language Learners, and low income. Commissioners discussed it at length.

Bud Jacobs presented on the Human Relations applicants.

Discussed by laws calling for parents representing each of the school levels.

Ray Lopez Chang had questions about the social emotional learning resolution's direction, actionable and potential for being meaningful

Reviewed request from Youth for Human Rights International. The website promotes L Ron Hubbard's writings. Commission will consider. Conditionally approved. \
