#### **Call to Order**

The meeting was called to order at 6:10 with quorum.

Minutes were approved with non-material changes.

Tanya Franklin, Partnership for LA Schools, reported on LCAP funding. Had a campaign *Fix It, Use It, Decide Together*. Schools were ranked based on need, based on metrics such as violence, injuries, asthma, college going, and supplemental and concentration monies awarded accordingly. Foster, ESL, Low Income are the state metrics for need.

She described ongoing efforts to refine the student-need index as they look at ongoing funding formulas. Push is to utilize equitable rather than equal funding. Asking that the board provides more time for the community to give input on budgets before adoption.

### **Human Relations Awards**

Notification about the awards is being sent to all SHHS staff and principals. Have not received any applications for awards yet.

Bud Jacobs will follow up with Forrest Financial about hosting the Awards event.

Bud Jacobs will reach out to the Museum of Tolerance to see if they can host the awards recognition event.

**DACA** – Judy spoke Michelle O'Neill from LA COE about the DACA efforts. O'Neill wrote, "Yes, I have met with the LAUSD team regarding collaboration on immigration and have been working with Nicole Mitchell on several immigration endeavors. So we've had a few opportunities to work together and are

looking for additional opportunities to partner on this hot topic. The work that LAUSD has been doing around this is unparalleled. So I have been thrilled to be able to collaborate with them on this work."
