**UTLA LGBTQ+ NCOD Event** Joe Laguna gave information about the UTLA Coming Out Day event at 7 pm at the Red Line in Downtown to promote forming the UTLA LGBTQ+ Caucus.

Project 10 Report of return of Project 10 Counseling Services For LGBTQ+ students

**Commission Acknowledgement** of appreciation to the LAUSD Board for bringing back Project 10. . Request for Commendation to be issued through The Board Informative. Allan provide a draft of the commendation for Board Members.

**Human Relations Commission Awards** After discussion on how to promote this important project, Bud proposed making a 3 minute video that showcases 2019 Awards for the purposes of increasing participation

**ADL** Annie gave a briefing of services ADL provides including training, consultation and assistance. Josh, Krystal, Gary, Annie and Bud to discuss ways to increase ADL support of Commission.

**Islam & Arab World Salary Point Class** Annie clarified that ADL's concerns with Jewish content contained historical errors. She clarified that their role is to respond when asked to weigh in but not to recommend curriculum.

**Ethnic Studies Update** Kaaras brought concerns re use of term Indigenous (a global term not reserved Native Americans) instead of Native American, diluting focus on the three largest native Californian tribes. Allan will invite Kylie Jackson to explain the changes from DOI to address the board.

**Title VI** Karaas shared concerns regarding results of current Bureau of Indian Affairs efforts. He is concerned that students are focusing on cultural knowledge in lieu of college readiness and resulting in no increase in college attendance.

**County Anti-Hate Program** Guest Theresa Villa McDowell offered to provide a chance to present on Anti-Hate Program and other efforts LA County is providing to the community at the October meeting.

**Museum of Tolerance** Krystal provided information regarding Museum of Tolerance's scholarship program for LAUSD students and educators, administrators, and other credentialed and classified staff.

**City of Los Angeles** Gary will look into the possibility of Los Angeles City Council offices providing transportation for students to MOT programs.

**Human Relations conference** Joel Laguna recommended a human relations conference be organized with the human relations awards recipients as presenters to other youth.

**Human Relations Awards** – most impressive event. Fourteen recipients. Possible partnership with ADL to offer leadership trainings. Suggest that the District invests in funding leadership training for the schools. Other SHHS offices want to participate this year.

**Alternative Policy to Metal Detectors & Wanding** (Meeting Saturday, September 14th, from 9:00 to Noon, Beaudry (Board Room). Board has voted against wanding. There will be a discussion regarding merits and concerns of this policy change.

National Coming Out Day and OUT for Safe Schools. The annual NCOD event is Friday, October 11th, 11:30-1:30. Commissioners are invited to attend. The theme is a 20/20 Vision for 2020 and will showcase student art.
