**AB493 of 2019— safe and supportive learning environments – sponsored by Todd Lara**

Affirms ed codes for safe and supportive for LGBTQ students with mandates trainings biennially

**Housing and Homelessness**

Shelley presented a written report. Areas of focus:

Clothing – facilities for laundry

Transportation – guaranteed to continue at the school. Problem is that elementary schools cannot ride public schools w/o adult escort. TAP cards take a few weeks to secure

Gary Painters is researching transportation models

Identification – homeless students are significantly under counted. Offer trainings to help teachers recognize markers (e.g., accessing food pantries, hygiene, meal applications)

Best Practices – Culver City has a Culver Needs committee that sends food home with student

Commissioners are asked to speak with their board members regarding addressing clothing/hygiene, identification, transportation.

Next steps: Outreach to Garcetti's office. Ron Galpin wants to be involved.

Cross track district resolution with the state mandates.
