Introductions. Guests Mathew Friedman (to speak about Ethnic Studies curriculum) and Dana Alpert (to speak about AB309).

January minutes approved by Shelley Rivlin, seconded by Bud Jacobs with no corrections.

Guest Dana Alpert spoke about AB 309 which is a bill to ensure that teachers are provided with training and protocols. She shared that data is showing that teachers are feeling inadequate navigating their students' mental health concerns especially given the covid 19 pandemic. AB 309 would establish a pathway for teachers to identify students in need of mental health and it provides training for teachers to improve their identification of students in need. The Commission will consider endorsing it.

Mathew Friedman (mfriedman@adl.org) from ADL Los Angeles spoke about AB331 that was Jose Medina's assembly member's bill about Ethnic Studies course becoming a high school graduation requirement. Organizations had sections that used language anti Jewish language. There was a second draft that was member and now in December came up with a third draft. After every draft there is a public comment period. Last public comment ended late January. Next public comment will be in March. The bill was vetoed by Governor Newsom because the curriculum wasn't ready yet. This is a model curriculum only. It will be reintroduced at the next legislative session.

Gary De La Rosa asked Mathew Friedman "is first version even close to current version?". Question by Gary De La Rosa also asked about who are the organization that removed themselves and reason.

According to Mathew Friedman the initial draft had content that was anti Semitic. He opined that there are so many different persuasions that it is very challenging to get agreement on content.

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Reports on Committees:

Housing Task Force: **Shelley Rivlin** reported on program called Kids First. This program seeks to provide services to children living in motels. 50 families started as pilot program but now down to 25 families only. Next task force meeting to include LAUSD housing and Nury Martinez' office to help identify locating the children/families.

Human Relations Awards- Bud Jacobs and Cristina Hudson met about having individual awards instead of schools/clubs. Proposed that there will be Human Relations Awards promoting social justice in the form of written word, art, etc. Discussion about whether to have winners (v. recognitions), how to ensure promoting in order to ensure cross representation/entries. Mark Abelson suggested not doing this during this year. Gary De La Rosa proposed finding out what students are already doing or have done and honor them. Bud Jacobs proposed finding these students by contacting the public relations unit for the information. Judy will reach out to the Office of Communications.

American Indian Education Program- Allan Kakassy is working with Sue Hawk to prepare a fact sheet.

School Culture/Educational Equity - J. Watts reported that there was no meeting with Joel due to illness. J. Watts shared "Black Child Suicide" report: https://caresmentoring.org/black_child_suicide_report.pdf Dr. Kimani Norrington Sands, co-author and LAUSD school psychologist.
