PURPOSE:	The purpose of this Memorandum is to announce the requirement for all Principals, Assistant Principals, and Assistant Principal Elementary Instructional Specialists to complete the District's online training, <i>Special Education</i> <i>Performance Indicators and Outcomes</i> regarding Special Education substantial compliance and performance indicators, along with the updated requirements for Modified Consent Decree (MCD) Outcome 13 – Delivery of Services.

<b>INSTRUCTIONS</b> :	All Principals, Assistant Principals, and Assistant Principal Elementary Instructional Specialists have been auto-enrolled in the <i>Special Education</i> <i>Performance Indicators and Outcomes</i> training in MyPLN (keyword – INDICATOR) and are required to complete the 30 minute training by October 31, 2018, and certify in accordance with MEM-6128.6 <i>Administrator</i> <i>Certification Online System 2018-2019 For School Sites and Offices</i> , Attachment B, pages four and five. For convenience, all other certificated staff have been auto-enrolled in the training as well and are encouraged to view it. The <i>Special Education Performance Indicators and Outcomes</i> training provides an overview regarding (1) indicators and outcomes designed to improve results for students with disabilities, (2) the use of Focus Reporting and Dashboards to self-monitor performance on the indicators, (3) procedures for analyzing performance, determining next steps, and addressing issues of noncompliance, and (4) updated requirements for the Modified Consent Decree (MCD) Outcome
