



MAGNET SCHOOLS AND CENTERS STAFFING RATIOS FOR FY 2023-24 AUGUST 2023

MAJOR CHANGES

- The staffing ratios for the Accelerated Academic Literacy program (Double Block Intensive Intervention English Language Arts Program) for select 6-8 and 9th grade magnet schools are discontinued effective FY 2023-24.
- For fiscal year 2023-24, class size in academic classes for Priority Schools will be reduced by 1 student in accordance with UTLA Agreement Article XVIII Section 2.3a.
- The state has enacted new class size and staffing rules for the youngest UTK students. Staffing guidelines are posted under the section “Universal Transitional Kindergarten.”
- For fiscal year 2023-24, Transitional Expansion Kindergarten (TE) students will be included in schools’ Norm teacher and aide calculations.
- To satisfy the state requirement and maximize the utilization of resources allocated for TE students, when TE enrollment is insufficient to create a class size of 20 students, the District norm allocation combines TE and TK up to grade 3 students to reach the 20:1 capacity. Please refer to the new section “Universal Transitional Kindergarten” for details of the calculation.

GUIDELINES

TEACHERS

- The teacher staffing ratios for Priority Schools in grades TK-3, 4-5(6), 6-8, and 9-12 will be reduced by one student. See Appendix 4 for list of Priority Schools.
- The teacher staffing ratios for all other schools in grades TK-3, TK-3, 4-5(6), 6-8, and 9-12 will be the same as those in place for the 2022-23 school year.
- Grade TE will now be incorporated into the norming. Please refer to the section on Universal Transitional Kindergarten and Appendix 1 for teacher calculation.
- For Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) reporting purposes, enumerated below is the determination of the funding or program code to be used for the norm teacher resources generated by the following norm tables:

Appendix 3 – Various norm tables for the 2017-18 Class Size for all Schools (Base)

- a) The norm teacher resources generated from the 2017-18 class size for grades 4-12 in Appendix 3 (Attachments A - B) will be allocated in program code 11020 (K-12 Norm Teachers).
- b) The difference between the norm teacher resources generated using the staffing ratios reduced in Appendix 2 (Attachments A & B) and the norm teacher resources generated from the 2017-18 class size for grades 4-12 in Appendix 3 (Attachments A and B) will be allocated in program code 10989 (TSP-CSR Teacher/Librarian).
- Norm Enrollment Adjustments - The following adjustments will be applied to Norm Day Enrollment for the 2023-24 school year:
 - o Age ineligible students-grade placement that does not adhere to the age eligibility rules for TE and TK. Schools should use the Chronological Age Calculator at <https://agecalculator.lausd.net/> to determine the correct grade placement of age-eligible students. Please refer to the table below for the 2023-24 Minimum Age Requirement for Enrollment in TE, TK, and K:

*Kindergarten-aged students may be placed in TK at the request of Parent and concurrence of School Administrator. Must have the completed Kindergarten Continuance form in school file.

**For UTK/CC classes, students who are TE-aged must be assigned to grade level TE, not PK.

- o Students with more than one enrollment record (duplicate students)
- o Students enrolled in one course only

The classification report provides counts of students with scheduled class(es) in their school of enrollment. For norm purposes, the classification report counts will be reduced to count only those students who are scheduled in two or more credit-bearing courses. Therefore, school should ensure that each student's complete schedule is

entered into MiSiS in time for the Norm capture. Refer to Attachment D for the list of non-credit bearing/zero credit courses.

- o No Show students (students who are scheduled into classes but have not attended school, i.e., marked absent each day) who were not flagged by the schools in MiSiS as No Show by Norm Day data capture will be manually deducted from the school's enrollment count.
- o Students with 13 absence days or more, from enrollment date through Norm Day
- In addition to ensuring that students are both enrolled and scheduled in MiSiS, school must also ensure that students are enrolled in the:
 - o Appropriate cost center (i.e., home school versus magnet center or dual language center). Students approved to be enrolled at the magnet center must be enrolled at the magnet center's cost center unless documentation exists to rescind magnet placement.
 - o Correct class(es) based on the student's IEP, if applicable.
 - o School staff must correct all enrollment errors, including incorrect cost center and class(es), before enrollment counts are captured for norm day, September 15, 2023.
- The SDP counts are modified when section assignments for students differed than what was called for in the Individualized Education Programs (IEPs).
- Special Day Program (SDP) students at Elementary School

Students enrolled in the class/section of a Special education teacher are categorized in the Classification Report as SDP. The total SDP counts are excluded in the calculation of general education norm teachers.

Special education teachers are assigned to elementary schools based on the number of students with special needs and their specific disabilities. Refer to Attachment C for the Special Education norm table guide. These class sizes are based on the Los Angeles Unified School District and United Teachers Los Angeles Collective Bargaining Agreement.

- Secondary SDP Student Count

Secondary students with an active Individualized Education Program (IEP) where the Percent Time in Special Ed is 50% or more are counted as SDP in the Classification Report. Moreover, SDP counts are modified when section assignments for students differed than what was called for in the IEPs.

The total SDP counts are excluded in the calculation of General education norm teachers. Special education teachers are assigned to middle and senior high schools based on the number of students with special needs and their specific disabilities. Refer to Attachment E for the Special Education norm table guide. These class sizes are based on the Los Angeles Unified School District and United Teachers Los Angeles Collective Bargaining Agreement.

- Pursuant to Education Code section 42238.02, as a condition of receiving a grade span adjustment for kindergarten through grade three (K–3 GSA), a component of Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF), school districts must make progress towards or maintain a K–3 maximum average class size of 24 or less at each school site. If the annual independent audit of a school district shows that a school district did not comply with these conditions, the California Department of Education (CDE) will retroactively reduce the school district’s funding.

The Education Code imposes financial penalties on school districts that exceed specified class sizes. To safeguard against financial penalties, the number of pupils assigned to individual classes may not exceed 33 in kindergarten at any time, 32 in grades 1-3 at any time, and 36 in grades 4-6.

Note: These limits also apply to “combination” classes. For purposes of the Class Size Penalties report to the California Department of Education, any class combining pupils in kindergarten or in any grade(s) 4 through 8 with one or more of Grades 1, 2, or 3 shall be considered a class of grades 1, 2, or 3. For example, if five (5) grade 3 pupils are added to a grade 4 class of 28, the class would be considered a grade 3 class of 33. In this example, a fiscal penalty would be assessed on the district because the class exceeded the class size requirement of 32 for grade 3.

- **Staffing Position Simulator**
“Position Simulator (Norm Allocation)” tool is available on the School Fiscal Services website (<https://www.lausd.org/Page/794>). The purpose of this tool is to provide schools with transparency as to how Norm Teacher counts are calculated based on their enrollment, Norm Category, and Affiliated Charter status. In addition to the Norm Teacher count, this tool will also calculate the number of Counselor, Administrator, and Clerical norm positions. Schools can also use the tool to assist with the norm calculation during the budget planning and development. The tool has been updated to help calculate your Transitional Kindergarten Teacher and Aide allocation.

After Norm Day, school resources are recalculated based on validated Norm Day enrollment, and schools may experience no change, an increase, or a decrease in resources. For teachers, new positions will be established based on enrollment growth, or existing positions will be closed based on enrollment decline.

FY 2023-24 norm tables for different norm categories reflected on Attachment A and B are based on total school enrollment, excluding elementary students categorized as SDP in the Classification Report and secondary students with an active IEP where the Percent Time in Special Ed is 50% or more.

- A. Magnet Schools and Centers identified as Predominantly Hispanic, Black, Asian and Other Non-Anglo Students (PHBAO) use Attachment A to determine teacher allocations.
- B. Magnet Schools and Centers identified as non-PHBAO use Attachment B to determine teacher allocations.

UNIVERSAL TRANSITIONAL KINDERGARTEN (new section)

The state of California has introduced new class size maximums and adult-to-student ratios for specific Universal Transitional Kindergarten (UTK) students. These requirements go into effect in the 2023-24 school year and will expire at the end of the 2024-25 school year. This section explains the new state laws and shows how norms are calculated to help ensure that the ratios and class size requirements are met.

UTK includes students who:

- Are turning 4 between June and September 2023. Effective July 1, 2023, these students are identified by the state as “early enrollment” students.
- Already turned 4 between September 2022 and May 2023

For enrollment tracking and norming purposes, the District will identify “early enrollment” students using the “TE” indicator in MiSiS, and all other UTK students as “TK” students. In 2023-24 only, “TE” students will also include those turning 4 between April and June of 2023.

Below are the new state rules on early enrollment students for UTK.

- Any classroom that includes TE students shall maintain an adult-to-pupil ratio of at least one adult to every 10 pupils.
- Any classroom that includes TE students shall not exceed 20 pupils.
- UTK classes without any TE students shall maintain an adult-to-pupil ratio of one adult for every 12 students, and a class size that may not exceed 24.
- The law goes into effect in 2023-24 and expires at the end of 2024-25.
- These ratios and requirements do not apply to Special Day classes.

The below steps demonstrate how to calculate your school site’s respective teacher and aide calculation with respect to TE students.

Teacher Calculation for TE students

To satisfy the state requirement and maximize the utilization of resources allocated for TE students, the District norm allocation combines TE and TK up to grade 3 students to reach the 20:1 capacity when TE enrollment is insufficient to create a class size of 20 students.

The grade group norm is determined as follows:

1. Round up the TE count to the next denomination of 20. This will be the TE/TK norm group.
2. Add TE to Grade 3 and subtract by the count in (1). This will be the TK-3 norm group.
3. Once the respective norm groups are identified, use table 1TE to determine the TE teacher allocation and the respective table in Appendix 2 to determine your TK-3 teacher allocation.

The following examples illustrate how students will be grouped for norming.

SCHOOL A

1. Round up the 11 TE students to the next denomination of 20, which is 20. Use table 1TE to determine your respective teacher allocation for the TE norm group.
2. TE to G3 is 108. Subtract 20 from 108, which is 88. Use the appropriate table from Appendix 2 to determine your respective teacher allocation for the TK-3 norm group.

Since there are less than 20 TE students, 9 TK students are added to 11 TE students to make a class of 20. The remaining 11 TK students are included in the TK-3 norm.

SCHOOL B

1. Round up the 25 TE students to the next denomination of 20, which is 40.
2. TE to G3 is 343. Subtract 40 from 343 which is 303.

20 TE students will form one class. 5 TE students and 15 TK students will form another class. The remaining 2 TK students are included in the TK-3 norm.

1. Round up the 20 TE students to the next denomination of 20, which is 20.
2. TE to G3 is 220. Subtract 220 from 20 which is 200.

Since there are exactly 20 TE students, no TK students are added to the class. All TK students are part of the TK-3 norm group.

Aide Calculation for TK students

TK Aides are calculated in a similar fashion.

In School A, there 11 TE students and 20 TK students.

1. Round up the 11 TE students to the next denomination of 20, which is 20. Under table 1TEA, they would receive one TK Aide for this group.
2. TE to TK is 31. Subtract 20 from 31, which is 11. Under table 1TKA, they would receive one TK aide for this group as well.
3. The school receives one TK aide for its TE/TK class, and another TK aide for the remaining 11 TK students that will be combined with K to form a class of 24:1.

In School B, there are 25 TE students and 17 TK students.

1. Round up the 25 TE students to the next denomination of 20, which is 40. Under table 1TEA, they would receive 2 aides for this group.
2. TE to TK is 42 total. Subtract 40 from 42, which is 2. Under table 1TKA, they would receive 1 aide for this group.
3. This school receives two TK aides for its TE classes, and another aide for its remaining 2 TK students that will be combined with K to form a class of 24:1. In total, this school receives three aides.

SCHOOL C

In School C, there are 20 TE students and 28 TK students.

1. Since there are 20 TE students, this automatically generates one aide according to table 1TEA.
2. Since there 28 TK students, this generates two aides under table 1TKA.
3. The school receives 3 aides total.

ADMINISTRATORS

- The administrator staffing will be the same as those in place for the 2022-23 school year.
- The Assistant Principal positions will be allocated in program code 10332 (TSP-Norm AP & APSCS).
- The allocation of norm administrative position(s) for Span Magnet Schools will be based on the total school-wide enrollment, including transitional kindergarten expansion, special day program classes (SDP), state preschool (SPS), pre-kindergarten special education using the Middle/Senior High School Administrative Staffing table.
- After Norm Day, school resources are recalculated based on validated Norm Day enrollment, and schools may experience no change, an increase, or a decrease in resources. For administrators, growth positions are allocated but reductions are not implemented.

Elementary Magnet Schools

Administrative personnel for elementary magnet schools are allocated using the table below and the total school-wide enrollment, including Transitional Kindergarten Expansion program, special day program classes (SDP), state preschool (SPS), pre-kindergarten special education.

- Starting FY 2021-22, the allocation of norm counselor positions for Span Magnet Schools is based on the Middle and Senior High Schools Staffing table displayed below using the total secondary enrollment, including enrollment in special day classes (SDP).
- The counselors at senior high schools and span schools will be allocated in program 14858 (TSP- Norm Counselors).
- After Norm Day, school resources are recalculated based on validated Norm Day enrollment, and schools may experience no change, an increase, or a decrease in resources. For counselors, new positions will be established based on enrollment growth, or existing positions will be closed based on enrollment decline.
- For fiscal year 2023-24, Priority Schools with an enrollment of 900 or more students in grades 9-12 will be given an additional counselor position to provide college counseling services.

- Starting FY 2021-22, the allocation of norm clerical positions for Span Magnet Schools is based on the Middle and Senior High School Staffing tables using the total school-wide enrollment, excluding enrollment in state pre-school. K-8 Span Schools will use the Middle Magnet School Clerical Staffing table. 6-12 and K-12 Span Schools will use the Senior High Magnet School Clerical Staffing table.
- Starting in 2020-21 fiscal year, the Modified Consent Decree clerical position has been changed to "Special Education Section Clerical Support". Sites do not have flexibility over this position.
- After Norm Day, school resources are recalculated based on validated Norm Day enrollment, and schools may experience no change, an increase, or a decrease in resources. For clerical support, growth positions are allocated but reductions are not implemented.

The 2023-24 norm tables provide one position for every 23 students in grades TK-3 classes for Priority Schools, and one position for every 24 students for other schools. For schools with TE students, allocation for TK-3 is based on the net of TK-3 enrollment after deducting the enrollment used for TE norm teacher calculation.

To prevent loss of Local Control Funding Formula TK through 3 Grade Span Adjustment funding, the school district must maintain a maximum average class size of 24 or less at each school site.

A class with 4th, 5th, or 6th grade students combined with any K-3 students is considered a K-3 class. Therefore, maximum average class size is 24. Attendance & Enrollment Section captures school month end enrollments for compliance with K-3 class size guidelines and will work with Regions in monitoring of class sizes.

The Education Code imposes financial penalties on school districts that exceed specified class sizes. To safeguard against financial penalties, the number of pupils assigned to individual classes may not exceed 33 in kindergarten and 32 in grades 1-3.

Note: These limits also apply to “combination” classes. For purposes of the Class Size Penalties report to the California Department of Education, any class combining pupils in kindergarten or in any grade(s) 4 through 8 with one or more of Grades 1, 2, or 3 shall be considered a class of grades 1, 2, or 3. For example, if five (5) grade 3 pupils are added to a grade 4 class of 28, the class would be considered a grade 3 class of 33. In this example, a fiscal penalty would be assessed on the district because the class exceeded the class size requirement of 32 for grade 3.

The 2023-24 norm table provides one position for every 24 students in grades K-3 classes. For schools with TE students, allocation for TK-3 is based on the net of TK-3 enrollment after deducting the enrollment used for TE norm teacher calculation.

To prevent loss of Local Control Funding Formula K through 3 Grade Span Adjustment funding, the school district must maintain a maximum average class size of 24 or less at each school site.

A class with 4th, 5th, or 6th grade students combined with any K-3 students is considered a K-3 class. Therefore, maximum average class size is 24. Attendance & Enrollment Section captures school month end enrollments for compliance with K-3 class size guidelines and will work with Regions in monitoring of class sizes.

The Education Code imposes financial penalties on school districts that exceed specified class sizes. To safeguard against financial penalties, the number of pupils assigned to individual classes may not exceed 33 in kindergarten and 32 in grades 1-3.

Note: These limits also apply to “combination” classes. For purposes of the Class Size Penalties report to the California Department of Education, any class combining pupils in kindergarten or in any grade(s) 4 through 8 with one or more of Grades 1, 2, or 3 shall be considered a class of grades 1, 2, or 3. For example, if five (5) grade 3 pupils are added to a grade 4 class of 28, the class would be considered a grade 3 class of 33. In this example, a fiscal penalty would be assessed on the district because the class exceeded the class size requirement of 32 for grade 3.
