

## How to Conduct a Town Hall Meeting

- 1. Each group will have a two-minute time limit to tell us whether they would support or oppose a space colony.
- 2. Each group must provide evidence from their citizen's group Opinion Card to support their recommendations.
- 3. Every participant in this meeting must listen carefully to all the speakers because at the end of the meeting a vote will be held to support or oppose the space colony. Other groups may present ideas different from your own and you might change your opinions based on this information.
- 4. No one may interrupt the group member who is speaking.
- 5. Each group must respect the opinions stated by the other groups.
