



How to Conduct a Town Hall Meeting



1. Each group will have a two-minute time limit to tell us whether they would support or oppose a space colony.
2. Each group must provide evidence from their citizen's group Opinion Card to support their recommendations.
3. Every participant in this meeting must listen carefully to all the speakers because at the end of the meeting a vote will be held to support or oppose the space colony. Other groups may present ideas different from your own and you might change your opinions based on this information.
4. No one may interrupt the group member who is speaking.
5. Each group must respect the opinions stated by the other groups.
