Tutoring Programs

One idea for providing additional supports to ELs is to implement a tutoring program that connects older students with younger ones. One example of a tutoring program that was implemented in another district was to use higher level high school Spanish students (students enrolled in AP Spanish, for example) to tutor Spanish-speaking elementary school students. The high school students had the benefit of practicing their Spanish with the elementary tutoring buddy, and potentially their family as well, and also earning required community service hours. The elementary student received the benefit of additional support in their English language development and classwork, including support in Spanish.
