The Resume Builder tool includes the following sections: Objective, Summary, Work Experience, Education, Extracurricular Activities, Awards, &amp; References. Resumes created via Resume Builder can be exported in both PDF and Word formats.</p>	
<p><b>Roadtrip Nation</b> The Roadtrip Nation interview archive is a digital career exploration tool that enables students to discover new pathways, interests, and ambitions. The archive includes more than 3,500 video interviews chronicling the diverse personal stories of leaders who have turned their interests into their life's work.</p>	
<p><b>StrengthsExplorer</b> StrengthsExplorer® is a strengths assessment that assesses 10 talent themes for individuals and identifies each student's three strongest emerging talents. Students will learn how to capitalize on their success and discover what they need to do next to continue building on their strengths. Themes include achieving, caring, competing, confidence, dependability, discover, future thinker, organizer, presence, and relating</p>	
<p><b>Career Profiles</b> The careers database allows to students to view career profiles and career cluster profiles to learn more about careers they are interested in. Information includes wages, related majors, recommended plans of study, career details, and employment outlook.
