


## Overview

## The Student Experience

**To access the Naviance College and Career Readiness Curriculum as a student:**

1. Log into Naviance Student.
2. Select the "College and Career Readiness Lessons" box, found towards the bottom of the Homepage.




3. Click the "Get Started" button for the desired lesson.

## The Staff Experience


**To Access Naviance College and Career Readiness Curriculum:**

1. Log into Naviance
2. Select "Naviance Curriculum" listed under "Quick Links".



### To View Lesson Plans:

1. Select "View All Lesson Plans" listed under Curriculum Options on the left side of the page.  
*Note: Lessons can be filtered by grade, title, or theme.*




2. Click on the title of the lesson to view or print the lesson plan.  
*Note: To see the lesson as a student select "Preview this lesson".*



### To view students enrolled in each sequence:


1. Click on the sequence name (ex: "8<sup>th</sup> grade Sequence") to view a list of students assigned to that sequence.



3. Select "Activity" or "Progress" to see additional information.  
*Note: More information about viewing "Activity" and "Progress" follows below.*

### To view student activity:

1. Navigate to "Grade 8 Sequence".
2. Select "Activity" to view detailed information,
3. Review the number of logins, lessons completed, etc.  
*Note: You can click on the column headers to re-sort student information. To advance to the next page, use the numbers at the top or bottom right side.*



4. Click “Download CSV”, found in the upper right-hand corner, to obtain the student activity in a spreadsheet format.

**To view student progress:**

1. Navigate to “Grade 8 Sequence”.
2. Select “Progress” to view completed lessons to date.
3. Click on a green check mark or student name to see individual student responses.

*Note: The “Students” row displays the number of students who have completed each lesson in the sequence.*
