WHAT IS E-CAR?

E-CAR is LAUSD's online capacity assessment review application, which is available to you 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, from any computer within the LAUSD network with an internet connection. E-CAR's screens include a campus map and a classroom inventory that allow you to verify the number of classrooms at your school and how they are used, to calculate your school's operating capacity, and to identify available classrooms for future use.

WHEN IS E-CAR?

For Alternate Curriculum Environment ("ACE") Schools, E-CAR 2025 opens on Wednesday, November 5th at 12:00 noon. The deadline for submitting information for your school is Wednesday, November 26th at 11:59 pm.

WHAT SCHOOLS ARE REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE IN E-CAR?

ACE Schools, which include Community Day Schools, Continuation High Schools, Opportunity Schools, Hospital Schools, Early Education Centers, Community Adult Schools, Skills Centers and Regional Occupational Centers, will all participate in E-CAR 2025. HOW DO I GET STARTED WITH E-CAR?

- Visit the E-CAR-ace website at https://www.laschools.org/new-site/my-school/ecar-ace/ and review the E-CAR pre-requisite reference materials that are designed to help get you started with E-CAR. These materials include timetables, FAQs, User Manuals, an E-CAR Specialist Contact list and MyPLN training information.
- 2. Get some training! Take the E-CAR 2025 general online training course on LAUSD's MyPLN, and follow that up with the ACE-school-specific *E-CAR ACE Schools User Manual*, which is available on the E-CAR-ace website at https://www.laschools.org/new-site/my-school/ecar-ace/.
- 3. Want expert help? Join our live, drop-in assistance sessions via Zoom. Remember to take the E-CAR 2025 online training course on MyPLN and to review your E-CAR-ace prerequisite reference documents *first*, then make sure to drop in within the first 10 minutes of a session's start time. - 4. Ready to start? Simply authenticate your LAUSD Single Sign-On User Account and log-in to the E-CAR ACE online application. To authenticate your LAUSD SSO, <u>navigate here</u> and enter your LAUSD SSO credentials when prompted. Do not include '@lausd.net' after your username. After receiving a "User Authenticated" confirmation message, you may access the E-CAR ACE online application at https://www.laschools.org/new-site/my-school/ecar-ace/. If you are prompted to log in, this time include '@lausd.net' after your username.
