Principals should complete and submit the report in the following cases: 1. External Positive test: An employee has tested positive with an outside testing agency (not LAUSD site).	Covid-19 Initial Exposure Management Report
Employee needs to be directed to submit his/her test results to the Covid-19 testing platform. 2. Suspected exposure: If an employee reports possible exposure please have them test and submit the COVID-19 INITIAL EXPOSURE MANAGEMENT REPORT. Get as much information when speaking with the employee to fill in the form as completely as possible.	
******IF AN EMPLOYEE TESTS WITH LAUSD IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO COMPLETE AND OR SUBMIT A FORM. Also keep in mind that students can also submit their test results online. At this time the CE form is only for employee cases.

To further educate our school administrators on the role of our SSS and A-G Counselors, I have attached a success story of our A-G Counselor at Roybal. Persistence pays off!!

17 y.o. student has had a history of chronic absenteeism and this year alone she has accumulated 75 full day absences out of a total 94 school days thus far. After several attempts to reach student and parent/guardian, it was becoming more evident to me that I might never meet her. I did reach out to staff members on my campus who have gotten to know her better throughout the years, including the Bridge Coordinator for Special Education, and was able to gain more insight about student's history. I learned that she has a lot of personal family issues as well as social emotional issues. I was determined to get ahold of student and be another person who tries to help her even if she declines the efforts. Therefore, I continued to reach out to her and one day to my surprise, on 1/26/2021, she responded to a message I had sent her via Schoology by telling me that she has not attended school for so long and it is too late for her to get a diploma. Student expressed that she does not know the first thing about distance learning and does not even know where to start if she were to decide to attend her classes. I helped student get on Zoom and I proceeded to go over our school's distance learning schedule, her class schedule, the zoom links to her courses, and her graduation standards. I made sure that student felt comfortable and that she could ask clarifying questions to be more prepared to take the first step of joining at least one class the next day. Once student saw proof that it was possible for her to graduate from Roybal, (she was not interested in continuation schools at this time) and knew exactly what buttons to click to get to her classes the next day she agreed to give it a try. Student not only attended the one class we agreed on for the following day but she attended every class for the next three days of school (and on time). I am continuing to send her affirmative messages each day and offering my support to help her continue attending because I know she has a pattern of attending for a few days and discontinuing for a long time and I am prepared to continue reaching out to her when and if that time comes. I have also been in constant communication with her teachers to make sure they are aware of the courageous step she is taking every day to join their classes so that they are positive, welcoming, patient, and help her catch up instead of questioning her about her many absences.
