During these uncertain times, it is important for educators to manage their self-care and to commit to building their own resilience. Building educator resilience is necessary in order to sustain the critical and impactful work in our school communities. The following are 3 ways educators can build resilience: Know yourself. Don't be afraid to engage in the foundational work of self-discovery. Self-knowledge helps educators become more empathetic toward others and confident about their actions. Build emotional intelligence. There has been an increase in social-emotional learning for students in school communities. However, busy educators tend to ignore their own emotions. At the foundational level, educators should be encouraged to recognize and name their emotions. Building emotional intelligence helps educators make sound decisions in challenging times. 
