
Sunday, March 14, 2021, Daylight Saving Time Starts At 2:00 a.m.

Reminder on Behalf of OGC: School Files Project

The LAUSD School Files application is the LAUSD application designed for Principals and Administrators to upload inappropriate behavior-related documents on a regular basis into the School Files system. This web-based application only requires a few entries to add documents. Please note that all user logins are recorded. Users are to upload documents as PDF files. Log in to the application using your SSO account at: https://schoolfiling.lausd.net. For specific instructions on completing this process, please contact your Staff Relations Field Director.

Extended Leaves of Absence (Workers Compensation or Illness)

It is the responsibility of the school site administrator to follow up on all leaves. For Workers' Compensation coverage, you should be in contact with the Claims Adjuster at Sedgwick to stay apprised of the employee's status and return date. If you need additional assistance with an employee, a current claim, or return to work procedures, contact the Integrated Disability Management office at (213) 241-3138. For employees absent due to illness for longer than twenty (20) days, formal Leave of Absence forms and other documentation must be submitted. Employees who have not submitted required doctor-approved leave documentation should be time-reported as unpaid after their 20th consecutive workday absence. However, should the required doctor-approved leave documentation be submitted late, payroll adjustments from unpaid should be strongly considered (Article XII, Section 12.9).

 VACCINATION GUIDANCE FOR EMPLOYEES – PRINCIPAL / SUPERVISOR COMPANION DOCUMENT The Moderna vaccine will be administered by Los Angeles Unified nurses and other licensed healthcare professionals to Los Angeles Unified employees. An e-mail verification will be sent to eligible school employees to schedule an appointment. The invitation is non-transferable. Employees will schedule their appointment at https://covidvaccine.lausd.net and will receive a confirmation email with a QR code which they must show at the time of check-in. Substitute Coverage and Notification Requirements: Employees will be allowed a three-hour window to receive their vaccination during their workday, including travel time, and their time will be coded as Miscellaneous Natural Disaster (MSND). Employees will notify their supervisor at least one day in advance of their vaccination appointment. 	Due: 6/30/21
 Classroom teachers will request a substitute teacher for the three-hour window via the Smartfind Express system and indicate "vaccination" as the qualifying reason. Funding will be provided by the District and time reporters will receive instructions and funding source information for substitute teacher coverage. Substitute teachers are requested for three hours but may be held over in the event of unforeseen circumstances. Employees will provide proof of vaccination via the DailyPass for time reporting.

COVID Testing Requirements Employees who report to District sites to perform their work duties are expected to participate in the District's COVID-19 Testing Program. Information on the program and scheduling testing appointments may be found at https://achieve.lausd.net/covidtesting . Employees with questions regarding the testing program may contact (213) 241-2700. For questions regarding employee compliance with these procedures please contact your Staff Relations Field Director or Senior Human Resources Representative.	
Isolation/Quarantine Time Reporting Employees who are directed by the Community Engagement (CE) Team to isolate or quarantine should be reported as MSND if remote work is not available. When the employee is cleared to return to work, the CE Team Member will provide an email to the employee notifying them they are cleared to report. Employees who are asked to isolate or quarantine by anyone outside of the District, and remote work is not available, will have to avail themselves of their benefit time.

Important Hotspot Update: Zero-Use Hotspots

Students need hotspots. We are aware of hundreds of hotspots that have not been used in the last 3 months. These are termed "zero-use" hotspots. Some are in inventory and some are checked out to students who are not using them. We are trying to retrieve these hotspots to redeploy to students in need. If you have not already received a zero-use hotspot report from your operations coordinator, please send an email request for one. The report shows which students are not using their hotspot. Please ask your IDM to reach out to the students to find out why, and request that they be returned to the school site if not needed. If you don't need recovered hotspots, please contact your operations coordinator and we will coordinate pick up from your school and redeploy to other sites as needed.

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

FAFSA Updates (REPEAT)	
 After March 2, there is still work to be done for FAFSA and CADAA submissions and completions: Students who submitted an incomplete FAFSA or CADAA can update the information and the status can be moved from "Submitted" to "Completed", closer to being eligible for a Cal Grant. WebGrant Administrators can use the "Financial Application (No GPA) Report" and students with a status of "No EFC" in the "EFC FLAG" column have an incomplete application. For students without a verified matched GPA (there are 802 as of February 28, 2021), school WebGrants administrators can make a manual match, or guide the student to make the changes to the demographic information necessary to make a match. Use the "NON-SSN GPA STATUS REPORT" and students with a status of "NO" in the "MATCH" column and data in the "MATCHED FIELD" column. (Note: the "MATCH" column also includes entries of "NO APP", indicating that the student has not submitted or completed an application. These students do not need a manual GPA match.)

FAFSA Updates	
 Several schools have FAFSA or CADAA applications on which the California Student Aid Commission has placed a "Hold". The school's WebGrants Administrator needs to contact the California Student Aid Commission directly at schoolsupport@csac.ca.gov or 888-294-0153. While the Cal Grants entitlement grants have a March 2 deadline, applications submitted after March 2 are eligible to be considered for one of 40,000 competitive Cal Grants awards that will be awarded in September. Historically, there are approximately 300,000 applications annually for these competitive awards. Any student interested in participating in LA Promise or California Promise must have a FAFSA or CADAA application on file, even if it is after March 2. Schools should encourage all students, even those not considering enrolling in college at this time, to have an application on file to be eligible.
