Already more than 37,000 staff members have received their first dose of the vaccine, are making an appointment to do so or have decided they don't wish to receive the vaccination at this time.</p> <p>All Los Angeles Unified employees are allowed to get vaccinated during the workday, whether through Los Angeles Unified's program or an outside provider, including time for travel to and from a vaccination site. Important Hotspot Update: Zero-Use Hotspots

Students need hotspots. We are aware of hundreds of hotspots that have not been used in the last 3 months. These are termed “zero-use” hotspots. Some are in inventory and some are checked out to students who are not using them. We are trying to retrieve these hotspots to redeploy to students in need. If you have not already received a zero-use hotspot report from your operations coordinator, please send an email request for one. The report shows which students are not using their hotspot. Please ask your IDM to reach out to the students to find out why, and request that they be returned to the school site if not needed. If you don’t need recovered hotspots, please contact your operations coordinator and we will coordinate pick up from your school and redeploy to other sites as needed.






