

Vaccines are available to all employees of Los Angeles Unified. Already more than 37,000 staff members have received their first dose of the vaccine, are making an appointment to do so or have decided they don't wish to receive the vaccination at this time.

Please ask your IDM to reach out to the students to find out why, and request that they be returned to the school site if not needed. If you don't need recovered hotspots, please contact your operations coordinator and we will coordinate pick up from your school and redeploy to other sites as needed.
