Important Hotspot Update: Zero-Use Hotspots  Students need hotspots. We are aware of hundreds of hotspots that have not been used in the last 3 months. These are termed "zero-use" hotspots. GUIDANCE FOR SITE ADMINISTRATORS AND SUPERVISORS REGARDING ASSEMBLY BILL (AB) 685:  Effective January 1, 2021, AB 685 requires notification to all employees, their labor representatives, and employers of contracted employees at a worksite of potential COVID-19 exposures, related benefits and protections, and disinfection and safety measures that will be taken at the worksite in response to the potential exposure.  Potential Exposure to COVID-19  If a site administrator or supervisor receives notice of potential exposure to COVID-19, the employer shall take the following action steps within one (1) business day of the notice of potential exposure. The COVID-19 Mandatory Compliance Alert (Attached), "Notification Checklist for Positive COVID-19 Cases" assists administrators to meet the requirements with California Labor Law. ## SPECIALIZED STUDENT POPULATIONS

This week we will highlight a story of collaboration and support to three families in a time of crisis.  Two SSS (Specialized Student Services) Counselors and the Homeless Education Office Counselor worked together to support families living together under one roof. The parents are siblings with their own children and grandmother who reside in the household with three LAUSD students across three school sites (Clinton MS, Trinity St. and Maple PC). The family was involved in a fire with a probable cause of electrical issues in the laundry room, which is where the fire appears to have originated. The family said that a part of the house burned down more than the other, this is why one family lost all of their clothes and the other two families were able to recover some clothing items/personal belongings. However, the house is no longer livable, which is why everyone in the household had to leave after the fire. All relatives moved into the hotel they are currently residing at, as it was being covered by the homeowner's insurance. Upon hearing of the fire, the SSS and HEO Counselors contacted Center Clothes Corner in Van Nuys who provided clothing and school supplies and the Homeless Education Office provided grocery store gift cards. The families were also given Grab and Go food center information closest to them, food banks in the nearby area, and low-income housing resources. This story speaks to the importance of how our counselors work together to meet immediate needs and support families at their most vulnerable times.
