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

<p>Dear Principals:</p> <p>The end of the year is around the corner and there is still much to be done. Schools are working hard to schedule and hold IEPs for students by the end of the year. In addition to holding IEPs, there almost 1000 IEPs comin up before the end of the year. Currently we have about 735 overdue IEPs and about 114 are initial IEPs. Initial IEPs have been very difficult to hold because of the impact COVID has had an the lack of available assessors we had during the closures. Now that we are back on campus, we can continue work to address these IEPs and ensure students have the supports and services they need. In order to provide targeted support to the schools that need the support the most, we are asking for schools to complete an Action Plan by May 12th and attend an IEP timeline clinic or COS Tactical the week of Math 17th. Mental Health Awareness Month:

May 1st marks the beginning of Mental Health Awareness Month. Throughout May 2021, LD Central PSWs will be launching campaigns at their assigned schools to shed light on this issue and to amplify the importance of mental health wellness. Here are some facts that underscore the urgency to dispel stigma and other barriers accessing mental health:

- Mental health conditions are common among teens and young adults. 50% of all lifetime mental illnesses develop by age 14 and 75% develop by age 24.
- 1 in 6 U.S. youth experience a mental health condition each year, but only half get treatment.
- Suicide is the 2nd leading cause of death among people aged 10–34 and the 10th leading cause of death overall in the U.S.

Julian Nava Learning Academy, PSWs and Support Staff, Stephanie Morales and Vanessa Oandasan, developed a Mental Health Awareness Month Challenge to promote mental wellness at their school.
