Students are 125 days smarter at Weemes ES. Students were treated to the red carpet welcome.

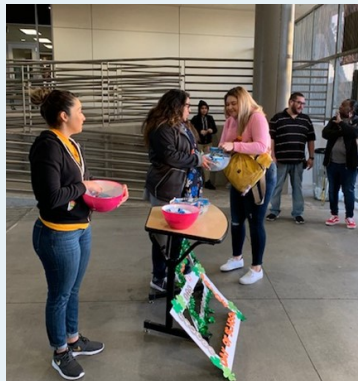


Marshall High School

It all stars for MacArthur Park students, greeted by staff as they walk into the 125th day of school!



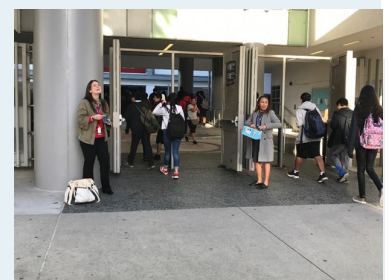
Foshay LC
