

As you are aware, the Superintendent is focused on parental involvement as one of the factors in improving children's education. One of the obstacles to obtaining more parental involvement, particularly in the schools in the lowest-income neighborhoods, is that parents are required to pay for a background check and related fingerprinting fees. Therefore, District has decided to absorb these costs.

Schools are asked to issue check(s) from their Imprest Account to reimburse parents/volunteers who have paid fingerprinting fees.
