Congratulations to the schools that met the District's attendance targets for the Fall 2018 semester!

- ⇒ 71 schools had "Excellent Attendance" (70% of students with 96% attendance): 3 Primary Centers; 46 Elementary Schools; 11 Middle Schools; 5 High Schools; and 6 Span Schools
- ⇒ 27 schools had a chronic absence rate of 9% or lower: 29 Elementary Schools; 4 Middle Schools; and 2 High Schools

Kindergarten Oral Health Assessment Mandate



California Education Code mandates an oral health assessment for all kindergarten and first grade students not previously enrolled in a public school. Parents/Guardians must present evidence of having an oral health assessment by May 31 of the school year. Schools are required to notify parents or guardians of this requirement, usually in the enrollment school packets, in the form of a notification letter with the Assessment/Waiver form.

Each school is required to collect Assessment/Waiver forms and enter data in MiSiS by **May 31st** of each school year. Please refer to [BUL-3585.6 Oral Health Assessment for Kindergarten or First Grade](#) for notification templates and guidelines on inputting data into MiSiS.
