# Responsibility for Loaned Devices Assigned to Students

This informs you of your legal responsibility with regard to the Device and its related accessories, which may include case, keyboard cable and battery charger ("Loaned Equipment") described below, that the Los Angeles Unified School District ("LAUSD") is loaning to your child.

The LAUSD may hold liable a parent or guardian of any minor who willfully cuts, defaces, or otherwise injures any property of the LAUSD, or fails to return any property of the LAUSD upon demand of the LAUSD, for all damages caused by the minor. (See, District Bulletin BUL-5509, Restitution Procedures for the Loss or Damage of School Property, dated June 19, 2012; California Education Code §48904.) LAUSD property includes the Loaned Equipment, which may have a value of up to \$700.

- I agree to the Security, Care, Usage and Responsibility conditions listed in the "Rules and Regulations" Concerning Use of Loaned Devices (i.e., Tablets or Laptops) Assigned to Students" ("Rules and Regulations"), on the previous page. My child's failure to abide by the Rules and Regulations, thereby resulting in damage to or loss of the Device, may be considered a willful act for which I am liable, subject to the following due process procedures set forth in Bulletin BUL-5509:
  - The LAUSD shall inform parent or guardian immediately in writing after any alleged loss which gives rise to an obligation under Section 48904 of the Education Code.
  - The parent or guardian may present information on behalf of the student, during a conference at the school, as to the reasons why a fee should not be imposed.
  - The principal/designee shall, after reviewing any information presented during this meeting, decide whether or not to withhold the marks, diploma, or transcripts and/or impose the fee for damages. The parent/guardian and student shall be notified in writing of the decision. The decision of the principal is final, and there is no appeal beyond the school level.
  - Upon receiving notification of the school's decision, the parent or guardian may, if necessary, pay the outstanding obligation, or the student may complete a voluntary work assignment determined by the school.
- The Loaned Equipment is, and will remain, the property of the Los Angeles Unified School District with the sole intended use for the student to whom it has been assigned.
- I further agree to abide by the LAUSD's Acceptable Use Policy for use of computer equipment and the LAUSD's computer network (see attached).
