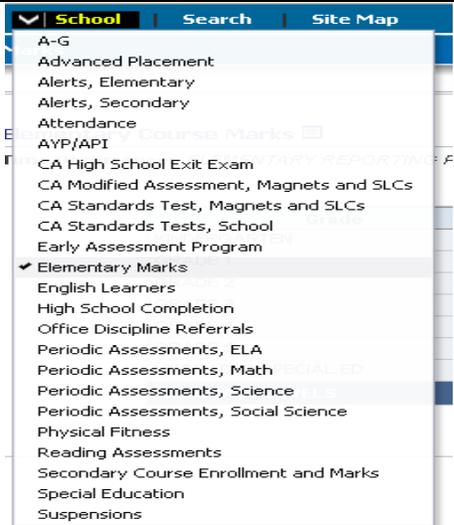
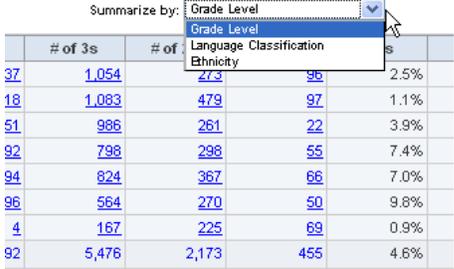


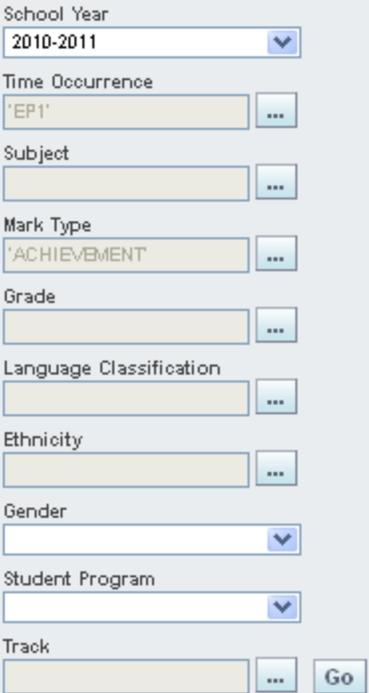
MyData Quick Guide: Elementary Marks, School

This report provides the number and percent of students earning marks of 1, 2, 3, and 4 by reporting period. This report is useful when summarizing student marks by various student attributes. For example, you may want to know your African American and Hispanic student marks after they participated in an intervention program focused on closing the achievement gap; this report can help you.

A. What are the Elementary marks for each grade level for the most recent school year and reporting period?

1.	Click on the “School” dashboard and scroll down to “Elementary Marks”.		
2.	You will see the “Time Occurrence” specifying the reporting period. The report displays the number and percentage of students receiving marks.		You can click on a number or percent in these reports to see a detailed student report. Student level detail reports include demographics, achievement marks and marks for work effort.
3.	Use the “Summarize by” selector above the report to toggle between displaying grade level, language classification and ethnicity.		A detailed student report is available for each attribute selected.
