






**Gifted Program Quick Guide**

Step #	Step	Icon/Link	Comments
1.	Click on the <b>School</b> menu at the top of the page, scroll down and click on <b>“Gifted Program.”</b>		Once you are in the Gifted Program dashboard, you will see a page with 3 different reports.
2.	The 3 reports will display data for Gifted students.		
3.	You can use the filters on the left-hand side of the page to limit the data that appears. You can select ESC, School Location Code, Cost Center or ES/MS/HS and hit the <b>“GO”</b> button.		You can also change the Track, Grade, Ethnicity, Language Classification, Gender or Poverty indicator. Be sure to click on the 2 <sup>nd</sup> <b>“GO”</b> button.
