Highlights for the Month

Registration for the **Annual Information Meeting** for NBC Teachers (mandatory) is available via MyPLN. Attendance at this meeting is required of all active and eligible NBC Teachers. The meeting dates are offered by regions. We encourage you to register by your region, however if you are unable to attend that date, you are welcome to attend another one that is offered. Please register as early as possible to ensure your spot is reserved. Upon verification of your attendance and submission of the attendance and reflection forms, you will receive the Task 2 Log from our office. Please save it by downloading the Log and placing it in your files along with the MyPLN certificate. The Task 2 Log and the MyPLN certificate will be required to submit for NBC hours.

NBCT's teaching at a school on the Eligible
High-Priority Schools List after January 1, 2025.

Teacher Development and Support (TDAS) Mentoring

Mentors wanted for new teachers! Make a difference in the life and career of a new teacher by mentoring. You can also earn NBC hours for providing support to teachers under Task 1 (see the guidelines for details on the different types of support that are eligible for NBC hours). Some new teachers are required to have a mentor assigned to them, and some are not. It depends on the type of credential the teacher holds, and the amount of years they have held the credential. This information can be provided to you by the new teacher. If the teacher is unsure, you can check the information on the CTC website under public search: https://www.ctc.ca.gov/

The PAC and Commitment Form documents were due June 10, 2024. If you haven't already done so, submit the required documents as early as possible.

Please check Schoology to verify your approved eligibility and any comments that may need to be addressed. If resubmission is required, please resubmit all required documents as a single PDF as early as possible.

Rename your Schoology Username using your LA Unified official First and Last name:

If you are currently using a title as your Schoology screenname instead of your first and last name, please change that setting. To do this, select your name from the upper right hand corner of your Schoology page, then choose Settings from the dropdown menu. In the Account Settings tab, uncheck the box that says "Display Title in place of your First Name" and then scroll down to the bottom of the page and save the new settings. Once saved, your correct first and last name should both appear on the upper right hand side of the screen. For example, instead of "Mrs. Smith", it should say "Jane Smith". We appreciate your support in resolving duplicate surname issues and in providing feedback to the correct person.

Task 1: Teacher Support Spotlight

MENTOR REMINDERS:

- Verify the credential of a new teacher or mentee to ensure they are eligible for support. Check the CTC website under public search and click on the ALL DOCUMENTS tab: https://www.ctc.ca.gov/
- Each mentee can be supported by only one NBC Teacher (NBCT).
- NBCT must record monthly teacher support hours on the online Monthly Mentor Log via Schoology by the 5th of each month.
- The Task 1 Log is a running record and should be signed each month when support is provided.
- NBCT will submit one Task 1 log per mentee each time an NBCT submits NBC Task 1 Hours (in November and/or April). The exception is if the mentee's eligibility status changes. Then, NBCT will start a new Task log matching the mentee's changed eligibility.
- All signatures are required to be in ink.

UPDATE:



- Technology support for teachers under Task If is no longer an eligible activity for NBC hours.
- New this year, for the month of August ONLY, NBCTs assigned to mentor a teacher under Task la, or who are supporting a teacher under Task lb-2, may log up to 15 hours of mentor support. This does not apply to TGI mentor support. This amendment will be honored by the TDAS branch. No further documentation will be required for the additional hours.
