Learning Objective # 1: ELAC parents will learn about the District's 2018 Master Plan for English Learners (ELs) and Standard English Learners (SELs).

Learning Objective # 2: ELAC parents will gain knowledge, resources and skills to support student academic achievement for ELs and SELs. **Learning Objectives # 3:** ELAC parents will learn instructional strategies used in classrooms which support student achievement for ELs and SELs.

Projected Outcome # 1: ELAC parents will support the Local District's efforts on training parents and schools regarding the new 2018 Master Plan for ELs and SELs.

Projected Outcome # 2: ELAC parents will strengthen their leadership skills to operate their ELACs in partnership with the SSC. **Projected Outcome # 3:** ELAC parents will become knowledgeable about students' language needs.

Rationale for Local District ELAC Study Group

The District English Learner Advisory Committee (DELAC) members requested training and support for the ELAC committees. DELAC members wanted to improve communication between the schools, the Local District and DELAC.

Local District ELAC Study Group Membership

The Local District ELAC Study Group is comprised solely of ELAC members who are either EL or SEL parents.

Local District ELAC Study Group Structure

The structure of the LD ELAC Study Group consists of two ELAC members from each school. Participation in the Local District ELAC Study Group is optional.

Local District ELAC Responsibilities

The current DELAC members will meet with their Local District Parent and Community Engagement Administrator and identify a series of topics which will be presented at the Local District ELAC Study Group. The Local District Superintendent will identify staff from the Local District who will present the requested topics. Workshops presented to the LD ELAC Study Group participants can be tailored to the specific needs of the school's ELAC. The LD ELAC Study Group participants will share the information they learned in the Study Group sessions with their schools' ELACs. The following topic recommendations were made by parents:


- Purpose and structure of the ELAC
