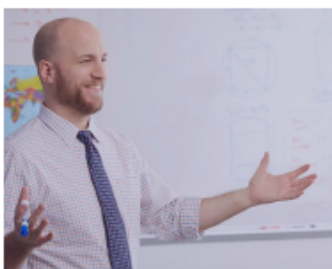

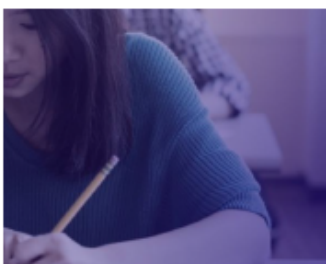

Kaplan Foundations Course Design

There are four mathematics, one science, four critical reading, and two language instructional units. Each lesson within the units is designed to be administered in 45–60 minutes. The focus of this program is to achieve content mastery and improve student performance on standardized tests. Each lesson follows a scaffolded pedagogy that is organized into three sections: Prepare, Practice, and Perform.

Elements within each lesson include:
