

## Program Elements

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The objective of the **ASISA Physical Education and ASISA After School Sports Program** is to create, organize and implement a physical education programming during regular and after school hours for elementary school students by providing athletic opportunities to a large group of students that otherwise won't have the resources to participate in youth sports. What it is guarantee with the ASISA program is that kids will dream they could athletes and even those who feel they don't possess athletic abilities will discover that every body is worthy and every one has the right to participate and have fun in physical education and sports.

The two elements of our program are:

1. **California Standard Based Elementary Physical Education Programming** during regular school hours. This program is taught by credentialed physical educators and is provided once or twice a week at elementary schools (K-6). ASISA will run all aspects of the programming which includes direct services to students, curriculum development, peer-mentoring to teachers in the area of physical education, fitness testing and ensuring program sustainability. ASISA will provide one (1) or two (2) teachers per school depending on enrollment and class sizes. All students enroll in the school site will be participants of our program. ASISA will provide the state mandated 200 minutes of physical activity instruction every 2 weeks and conduct fitness tests. If allows because our teachers are credentialed, ASISA will evaluate and grade students as well.
2. **After School Sports Programming.** This particular program runs like a sports academy after school hours where students stay after dismissal and choose which sport they would like to participate in. There will be different sports stations set up (soccer, basketball, flag football, cheer); or ASISA will schedule sports seasons throughout the school year. The program runs once or twice a week at elementary schools (K-6). Various ASISA coaches will work at a specific site to ensure that a large number of students will benefit from our services. There will be athletic competition among the sites participating in the program to create community togetherness. Each student participating in the program will receive an ASISA shirt.

Other elements that school sites, school administration, parents and students will see and experience with our programs are:

- The ASISA Physical Education and Sports Program will be offered at elementary schools in LAUSD during regular school as well as after school hours
  - The program will consists of teaching the fundamentals and skills, practice and application of those skills in game situations.
  - ASISA teachers will teach students the most popular sports and games amongst youth: soccer, basketball, flag football, volleyball, softball/baseball and cheer.
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- ASISA will be serving approximately 5-10 schools a week. Each school will be served once or twice a week depending on schools needs and funding.
- Each school will be served ideally for 40 weeks (entire school year)
- Each school will have its own sports academy.
- ASISA will conduct mini camps at the site by setting up stations. For example: soccer, flag football, basketball and cheer. Other sports like volleyball and Ultimate Frisbee will also be available.
- ASISA will provide 1 or 2 teacher per school during physical education instruction depending on class size and multiple coaches during the after school sports program.
- There will be a tournament among the school participating at the end of the season.
- The tournaments will be on Saturdays at one of the school site and will run from 8:00 am to 1:00 pm.
- Each student participating in the tournament will receive a medal and an ASISA shirt.
- Schools could use the Saturday Tournament as Attendance Recovery Day.
- ASISA will provide all the sports equipment and materials.

## Price Schedule

**Package#1:** Schools may select to have a combination (schools will chose both programs) of **physical education programming** during regular school hours (**6 hours/6 periods**) and **after school sports programming (2) hours**. Each hour will be considered one class period for the physical education component. We will be serving approximately 35-70 students per class in physical education. In this option, we will be serving the entire school's student body for physical education while the after school sports programming will be 2 hours where ASISA will serve approximately 40-150 students per session.

This price includes teaching (we will have multiple teacher and coaches at each school site after school and teachers during school hours), uniforms, equipment, medals, tournaments expenses and all other program expenses. The price to the schools will be **\$ 281.25 per hour/ \$2,240 per school per day**. The price will be approximately **\$90,000 per school per 40 weeks** based on 8 hours of service per week per school.

**Package #2: California Standard Based Elementary Physical Education Programming.** The proposal price will be **\$375 per hour or \$2,250 per day** of service. Each hour will be considered one (1) class period. We will be serving approximately 35-70 students per class. School may schedule their classes so we their entire school's student body in that particular day.

This price will include instruction, teacher's salaries, equipment and any other program expenses. The price will be approximately **\$90,000 per school per 40 weeks** based on 6 hours of service per week per school.

**Package #3: After School Sports Programming.** The proposal price will be **\$562.50 per hour/\$1,125 per day/\$2,250 per week**. This program will run twice a week at each school site. Each session will be 2 hours twice a week. We will serve approximately **40-150 students per session**. This price includes teaching (we will have multiple coaches at each school site), uniforms, equipment, medals, tournaments expenses and all other program expenses. The approximately cost per site will be **\$90,000 per school per 40 weeks**.

## Vendor Virtual Services Plan

Due to school closures, approved vendors on the Partners for Student Success bench that have a signed contract will need to submit their *Vendor Virtual Services Plan* to D’Sonya Oakley at [dsonya.oakley@lausd.net](mailto:dsonya.oakley@lausd.net) from the Office of Partnerships and Grants. The plans will be vetted and shared with eligible schools to select the services they are interested in and follow up with vendors. Any new approved vendors that are in the process of signing their contract will also need to fill out the below form.

- Currently, certificated staff are required to supervise any services rendered to students by a third party.
- Recording and pictures of students is prohibited.
