

PROGRAM ELEMENTS

Literary Masters

Our Literary Masters Forum is geared for students in grades K-12, instruction is aligned with state adopted academic content standards, all the activities and curriculum used throughout our program will support and scaffold different levels of language arts proficiency. The program will allow for practice through activities that will improve a student's proficiency and fluency in language arts through activities such as: publishing a story, participating in grade-level book clubs or through other learning experiences. If story publishing is selected, students will write using the writing process: prewriting and processing of their ideas to develop their writing topic, creating and developing their story through the drafting process, editing process, and publishing of their work while addressing several language art standards. Students that participate in Book Club activities will be able to read and access grade-level appropriate literature selections that will allow for students to improve fluency, develop and improve literacy comprehension, and respond to literature which will give students to develop mastery of standards. Guest authors, illustrators and other professionals can be scheduled to present to the students to give them insight as to how language arts play a significant role in their career.

Problem Solvers

"Problem Solvers" is aligned with grades K-12th state standards and provides practice to improve student proficiency and number sense, basic operations, algebra, geometry, measurement, mental math, and problem solving. This program also prepares students for testing situations by offering practice across a variety of math stands.

Participating students will have small group tutoring focusing on helping students to meet the achievement gap by reviewing, reinforcing, and reteaching skills previously taught. Students can learn how math relates to different life situations and careers such as: bakers, bankers, restaurant owners, etc. Students will master skills in a way that is relatable to them personally.

Tutoring – Math/Language Arts

The focus of our tutoring will be to help students close achievement gaps, through skill intervention, homework assistance, and studying skills allowing standards to be met. Tutoring will take place two to three times per week for one hour sessions. Students from partnering schools can also have access to individualized/small groups tutoring in English Language Arts (ELA) or Math. An individualized standards based learning plan for the student will be created based upon consultation and observations made by parent and school as well as pre-test that will be administered during the first session. A post-test and progress assessment will take place during the last tutoring session. Tutoring can take place both in person and online.

Health and Fitness

Our Health and Fitness program is designed to implement physical instruction/education based on grade level and state standards. Students will have access to physical activities appropriate to grade level, specific “Sport Club” (soccer, basketball, or cheer), and health and nutrition classes based upon what is required by the school. Curriculum for physical activities/games and “Sports Club” will be developed by !!!Apple iPad & Android Tablet Tutoring!!! In addition to promoting fitness through physical activity, students will learn about health and nutrition as part of a lifestyle through discussing healthy food choices, as well as alternatives and healthier recipes. Our program may take place during school or after school.

Visual and Performing Arts

Our Visual and Performing Arts program is structured to educate students through the use of dance, music, theater, and visual arts. Some activities that our students will participate in are printmaking, painting, drawing, dance, story writing and improvisation, reader’s theater, music and crafts. Students can experience the arts through virtual field trips, recorded musical and theater performances. Student art work/performances can be displayed for the school to view or performed during assemblies so that the skills learned are showcased for their community. Local artists, performers, art/craft centered entrepreneurs may be invited to participate and share their work, skills and career experience with students.

PRICE SCHEDULE

!!! Apple iPad & Android Tablet Tutoring !!! will provide the following services at each school that partners with us.

Services will be provided up to five days a week for ten weeks or longer for two hours a day. The session will be broken down to 20 students per group.

After School Arts Program (Visual and Performing Arts) per session: \$260.00

Health and Fitness (physical instruction/education) per session: \$260.00

Below are highly intense one on one or small group of 1-5 students. Services will be provided up to five days a week for ten weeks or longer for two hours a day. School may choose 2 to 5 day a week program.

Literacy Masters / K-12 Enrichment for English Language Arts/ \$65.00 an hour per student or \$100 an hour for small groups of 1-5.

Problem Solvers: K-12 Math Enrichment \$65.00 an hour per student or \$100 an hour for small groups of 1-5.

Tutoring – K-12 Math / Language Arts \$65.00 an hour per student or \$100 an hour for small groups of 1-5.

Work based Learning Plan (\$65 one on one per student or \$100 an hour for small groups of 1-5) this price includes all costs of resume writing, training in desired field of student, computer skills ie: word, excel & power point.

*Since all schools, student populations and budgets are different the fees listed above are fully negotiable depending upon overall program structure.

All sessions and educational classes will take place at the school site during school, after school or virtually.
