**BACKGROUND**: The California Education Code states that a Local Educational Agency (LEA)

shall provide for the identification and assessment of the exceptional needs of an individual and the planning of an instructional program to meet the assessed

needs.

The California Education Code also states that a pupil complies with the residency requirements for school attendance in a school district, if he or she is

a pupil for whom inter-district attendance has been approved.

**INSTRUCTIONS:** The following policy remains in force regarding initial assessment of students

attending school on a general education inter-district permit.

1. Requests for initial assessment for Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) resident students attending school in another school district on a general education inter-district permit shall be the responsibility of the

district of attendance.

2. Requests for initial assessment for out-of-district resident students attending school in LAUSD on a general education inter-district permit shall be the

responsibility of LAUSD.
