<i>Progress reporting</i>		Report Card (based on the PLF; second semester PLF and consideration if students are on target to meet K expectations by the end of kindergarten)	No Report Card at this time
<i>Promotion</i>		Can be promoted to 1 st grade if they demonstrate social emotional skills/maturity and academic excellence (achieving at top 5% of LAUSD K students-meeting benchmark in all K assessments. See Ref-5777.3)	Cannot be promoted to 1 st at the end the school year because they will not be age eligible for 1 st grade
