## Background



Starting in 2021 –22, the California state budget provides IEAs with an additional 15 percent concentration grant add-on to hire additional school level staff in schools with greater than 55 percent enrollment of students who are foster youth, English learners, and low-income.

In order to maximize flexibility for schools without creating the need for an additional site plan, LAUSD created the **School Staffing Equity Grant**, through which eligible schools received funds to purchase at least one full-time equivalent position from a short-list developed through a community survey.

## Eligible Positions for 2023 - 24 Grant



- Psychiatric Social Workers
- Academic and college counseling staff
- Class size reduction teachers
- Health care assistants / health office clerks
- Career Technical Education teachers
- Community Representatives
- Restorative Justice Advisors
- Student/Family Navigators and Ambassadors
- PSA Counselors
- Intervention Teachers / Coordinators
- Paraprofessionals (instructional aides, education aides, teacher assistants)
- Office staff
- Custodial staff

\* Note that funds may be spent on a full - time or itinerant position listed above.

\*In addition, schools may purchase supplemental time or substitute days

\*Schools must also set aside 3% Potential Funding Variance.
