## GENERAL EDUCATION NORM PROGRAM CHANGES EFFECTIVE FY 2023-24

- The District allocates norm staffing resources to support the operational and instructional needs of schools. In FY 2023-24, the District will realign norm resources with the programs that fund them and the level of discretion schools may exercise. Some norm resources are allocated based on collective bargaining agreements, state requirements and/or district policy; therefore, they must be used for their intended purposes.
- Effective fiscal year 2023-24, the following resources previously budgeted in program 13027 are moved to new program codes.
