College and Career Readiness Survey Background



The **College and Career Readiness Survey** (CCRS) is an annual survey administered in the spring to 12th grade students only. Survey results provide the District, schools, students, and families with very **important information** on high school students' experiences in planning for, applying to, and enrolling in college, as well as their career planning. Results are shared with schools and posted on the CCRS Results Dashboard.

The survey ask students questions about:

- The type of college and career support they received
- The colleges students applied and were admitted to
- The types of financial aid they have been awarded
- The colleges at which they plan to enroll in
