Office 365 System Requirements

Objective

This document explains which operating systems (Windows or Mac), web browsers and Microsoft Office versions will work with Office 365.

Supported web browsers

Office 365 supports all the popular web browsers available today. Please refer to the list below:

- **Internet Explorer 11 & 10.** Both these versions of Internet Explorer are recommended for the best experience using Office 365.
- **Internet Explorer 9 and 8.** It is currently possible to access Office 365 using these older versions of Internet Explorer. However, both versions are not designed to work with Office 365 and as such not all features are available. We recommend you upgrade to using either Internet Explorer 11 or Internet Explorer 10 instead.
- **Mozilla Firefox, Google Chrome and Safari**. Office 365 is designed to work with the current or immediately previous version of Firefox, Chrome or Safari.

Supported operating systems

Office 365 is designed to work with the following operating systems:

- Windows 8
- Windows 7
- Windows Vista with the latest updates installed. More information can be found below: http://windows.microsoft.com/en-us/windows-vista/learn-how-to-install-windows-vista-service-pack-2-sp2
- Mac OS X 10.5 and later versions

Please note that Windows XP is not designed to work with Office 365. Although Office 365 will not block you from connecting from a computer running Windows XP, you should expect the user experience to diminish over time. As such, we recommend you access Office 365 from one of the supported operating systems listed above.

Supported versions of Microsoft Office

Office 365 is designed to work with the following versions of Microsoft Office in mainstream support:

- Office 2013
- Office 2010 with the latest updates installed
- Outlook for Mac 2011 with the latest updates installed

Please note that Office 365 is not designed to work with Office 2007. Although Office 365 will not block you from connecting using Office 2007, you should expect the quality of the user experience to diminish over time. As such, we recommend you access Office 365 from one of the supported versions of Microsoft Office listed above.
