Covered Services	Cost	
Prenatal and postnatal office visits	No charge	
Hospital delivery including C-section	\$100 copayment + 10% coinsurance per admission	
Newborn care through the first 30 days	No charge	
Contraceptives	\$25 copay	
Injectable contraceptives	\$50 copay	
Intrauterine Device (IUD)	\$50 copay	
Midwife	No charge (must consult medical group for availability)	
Alternative birth centers	\$100 copayment + 10% coinsurance per admission (must consult medical group for availability)	
Breastfeeding support, supplies and counseling. Limited services (partial coverage) benefits	No charge*

Artificial insemination	Covered at 50%	Cost share aligns with the cost share applicable to the type of service provided
In vitro fertilization (IVF)*	Not covered	Cost share aligns with the cost share applicable to the type of service provided
Zygote intrafallopian transfer (ZIFT)*	Not covered	Cost share aligns with the cost share applicable to the type of service provided
Gamete intrafallopian transfer (GIFT)*	Covered at 50%	Cost share aligns with the cost share applicable to the type of service provided
Infertility drugs	Covered at 50%	Cost share aligns with the cost share applicable to tier 1, 2, 3, or specialty drug copayment




Health Net Doula Programs

Doula Programs are available at no cost to our members throughout their pregnancy, during labor and delivery, and after birth.

Doula care includes pregnancy that ends in stillbirth, miscarriage or abortion.

Health Net offers our Members <u>TWO</u> Choices for Doula Services!





Individual Doula Program

A doula is not a medical professional and does not provide medical care or advice.

WHAT DOES THE PROGRAM OFFER?

- Individual birth worker
- Consistent care, same doula each visit
- Available in-person or virtually throughout pregnancy, during labor & delivery, and after-birth
- In-person visits at home, hospital, doctor office or other location
- Personalized in-person guidance and education
- Helps member & family communicate their preferences to the care team
- Assists member adjust after birth to newborn

WHAT SERVICES ARE INCLUDED?

- Free no cost services to member & employer
- A 90-minute initial visit
- Up to eight additional visits, including pre-and-post birth visits
- Support during labor and birth
- Up to two (2) additional visits after birth to discuss breast feeding, mental health, and other concerns.
 Visits last 3 hours.
- Help to navigate the health system, schedule appointments, connect to specialists, and community resources

Members may choose an Individual Doula or Mahmee, not both

MATERNAL HEALTH DIGITAL PLATFORM

WHAT DOES THE PROGRAM OFFER?

Rolling 12-months of service throughout pregnancy, labor/delivery, and after birth via the app.

- Virtual doula services*
- Wrap around services from a multimodal care team.
 - Registered Nurses for high-risk pregnancies
 - Infant feeding specialists
 - Mental health coaches
 - Nutritionists
 - Care Coordinators
- Digital services include 1:1 visits, group chats, individual & group classes, coaching, direct messaging, and access to articles, videos, and more.

WHAT DOULA SERVICES ARE INCLUDED?

Virtual doula services* include:

- Initial intake visit
- Unlimited prenatal visits
- Support during labor and birth
- Unlimited postpartum visits

Up to 2 extended in-person postpartum visits after birth (where available), visits may last up to 3 hours

*In-person services may be available in select counties, members to call Mahmee directly for more information.

Doula Program Comparison

INDIVIDUAL DOULA PROGRAM

- Individual birth worker
- Consistent care, same doula each visit
- Available in-person or virtually throughout pregnancy, during labor & delivery, and after-birth
- In-person visits at home, hospital, doctor office or other location
- Advocate for member & family birthing preferences, and needs
- Personalized in-person or virtual childbirth guidance and education
- Assists member adjust after birth to newborn care, inclusive of infant feeding education and evaluation

MAHMEE WITH WRAP-AROUND SERVICES

- Multimodal care team providing virtual & in-person support throughout pregnancy, labor/delivery, and afterbirth
 - Doula services (more than 1 doula)
 - Nurse led remote patient monitoring
 - Infant feeding education and consultations
 - Mental health coaching
 - Nutrition guidance
 - Childbirth education
 - Screening for social determinants of health
 - Care coordination
- Access to digital services with 1:1 visits, group chats, individual & group classes, coaching, and direct messaging
